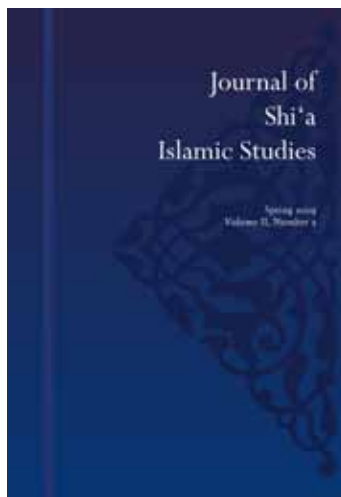


Journal of Shi'a Islamic Studies
